



GUIDELINES FOR HOSPITALITY ESTABLISHMENTS DURING COVID-19

Reference is made to Cabinet resolutions of 26th August 2020 and 10th September 2020, the Ministry of Local Government (MINALOC) and Rwanda Development Board (RDB) jointly issue additional guidelines:

- 1. All bars, including those in hotels and restaurants, remain closed;
- 2. Restaurants including those in hotels and other accommodation establishments may serve alcoholic drinks to only seated customers who order food;
- 3. Establishments must ensure all customers respect social distancing of 1.5 meters between seats and 2.5 meters between tables;
- 4. Staff must properly wear face masks at all times;
- 5. Establishments should avail washing facilities or hand sanitizers at all entrances and in any other public places within the establishments;
- 6. Customers who do not wear or properly wear face masks should not be allowed in the premises;
- 7. Establishments must place notices reminding clients and staff to respect COVID-19 preventive guidelines;
- 8. Selling or buying alcohol beverages from supermarkets and shops is allowed; however it is prohibited to consume alcohol from these premises;

9. Concerned public institutions and the business community are required to ensure effective implementation of these guidelines.
