

PUBLIC NOTICE

Monday, 25 May 2026

Following the public notice issued by Rwanda's Ministry of Health regarding enhanced Ebola prevention measures, the Rwanda Development Board wishes to inform the public that all activities in Rwanda continue as usual, including tourism, conferences, events, business, and travel within Rwanda.

There are **no cases of Ebola** within Rwanda, and measures are actively in place to safeguard public health and the well-being of residents, visitors and non-human primates.

TRAVEL GUIDANCE

Enhanced entry control measures

To further strengthen preparedness, the Ministry of Health has reinforced health screening and vigilance at land points and at the Kigali International Airport.

- ✔ All foreign nationals who have travelled to, or transited through, the DRC within the last thirty (30) days prior to their intended travel to Rwanda will be denied entry.
- ✔ Rwandan nationals and foreign residents with valid proof of residency in Rwanda will be permitted entry. However, those who have travelled to, or transited through, the DRC within the same thirty (30) day period will be subject to mandatory quarantine procedures in line with public health protocols.

Enhanced hygiene measures

As part of Rwanda's proactive public health preparedness efforts, health screening and surveillance measures have been reinforced at key points of entry, including Kigali International Airport and selected border posts.

- ✔ Travelers who have recently visited or transited through areas identified as high-risk by health authorities may be subject to additional screening and public health protocols in line with international health regulations.
- ✔ Visitors and residents are encouraged to continue observing standard hygiene practices and to follow guidance provided by health authorities where applicable.

Tourism and Events continue as usual

- ✓ Rwanda remains open for tourism, conferences, business activities and events. National parks, hotels, conference venues and tourism facilities continue to operate normally while maintaining appropriate health and safety standards.
- ✓ Visitors are encouraged to enjoy their planned activities with confidence while adhering to recommended public health practices.

Rwanda's public health readiness

- ✓ Rwanda has a strong and well-coordinated public health system with established surveillance, rapid response and infection prevention mechanisms. Relevant institutions remain vigilant and prepared to respond promptly to any potential public health risks.
- ✓ The Government of Rwanda continues to work closely with regional and international health partners to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents, visitors and wildlife.
